Poles & 1D - Joni Haderlie

Howdy is 9 this year. I have had him since he was born. I bought him from my parents who are the breeders. I have been riding horses and running barrels since I was 5. I do it because I love it. It doesn't matter what horse I am riding if it is a young horse or one I have been riding along time, I love it. One thing about Howdy is that he loves it too. He loves to turn barrels. He gives 100% every time. That makes it even more fun for me.

Open – Jan Brangle

I grew up with horses, mostly doing 4H and Gymkhanas. I took a couple long breaks from riding when my girls were growing up and it was all I could do to keep them mounted. When Kristi was in college, her HS rodeo horse was standing in the barn so started riding and running barrels on him.
