



August in Heber 2017 UBRA Rules, Clarifications & Disclaimer

- **NO DOGS** allowed in the indoor arena.
- **Horse must be named on entry form.** Please enter with horse's registered name.
- **Horse and rider must run in order drawn** or be disqualified. There is no charge for a horse change in the Youth and/or 5D for horses that are not already included in the draw. Please see the office before 11:30 am.
- **Youth 3D** will be a full second split for any rider 15 and under day of the race. Youth can carry over into the Open 5D & Target Race and will run after the Youth Sat. and Sun. Youth 3D Average awards will be based on the fastest time from each day.
- **Open 5D** will be ½ second split and will run after the Youth 3D. 70% of entry fee & 100% of added money will be jackpotted. 5D Average awards will be based on the fastest time from each day.
- **\$1000 Cash Target Race** side-pot, horse and rider with the two closest times Sat & Sun will win \$1000 cash! Target prizes will also be awarded.
- **Men's race** Friday night is 4D (1/2 sec). Outdoor arena
- **2D Futurity Side-Pot** Saturday and Sunday. Full sec split for first year futurity eligible horses 4 and 5 years old.
- **Stuck in the Middle & 50+** Side pots are 4D, ½ sec split.
- **No Dress Code**
- **Youth and 5D Pre-entries** must be postmarked by 8/11/17 to avoid a \$10 late fee. Late entries for Youth and Open 5D will be taken the day of the race until the last runner and will be charged a \$10 late fee. Late entries taken on Saturday for both days will run at the end on Saturday and Sunday.
 - Pre-entered day runners will be included in the draw. There will be separate draws done for the Youth and Open 5D Saturday and Sunday. Late entries will run at the end both Saturday and Sunday. Late draw will be completed during the big drag before the last 50 pre-entries.
- **Running Order:** Saturday & Sunday running order will be: 9:00 am Youth 3D, Open 5D. Sunday Youth Average Awards Presentation at big drag at 50 during open. Sunday 5D Average Awards Presentation. Must be present or have a designated person pick up your award at the race.
- **All runners will enter the arena thru the alley way** and exit out the alley way. No exceptions. One circle is allowed. Any runner entering from anywhere other than the alley way will be disqualified. If you are in the warm-up arena, please be cautious and courteous of horses running in and out of the alley way. The next 15 runners will be the only horses allowed in the warm-up arena.
- **Horses will not be worked on markers** and barrels are not allowed in the indoor arena during open ride or any other time April 25, 26, 27, 2017, except during UBRA time only.
- **Stall and RV** Reservations are handled by Wasatch County: visit www.utbra.com August page, follow the link to Wasatch County's stall reservation system. Stalls will be reserved upon full payment. If you are going to be late make sure you have made arrangements with the county ahead of time. No outside shavings allowed and please do not tie horses to trailers overnight. Dogs are not allowed inside the arena.
- **WPRA:** Rider must be WPRA member to enter WPRA Side-pots and can enter one time/one horse.
- **2D Derby** is ½ sec. split, open to all 2nd and 3rd year horses 5, 6 & 7 years old. WPRA co sanctioned.
- **Dr/Vet Outs** 70% of 5D entry fee will be refunded with Dr/Vet release. Must notify office before race starts. Refunds will be mailed.

By signing and submitting this entry, I agree that I have been informed of the Utah Equine Activities Law (U.C.A. 78B-4-201 et seq.) and that there are certain risks inherent to my participation in an equine or livestock activity. I acknowledged that those inherent risks include dangers or conditions which are an integral part of equine or livestock activities, and may include the following: (a) the propensity of the animal to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, or death to persons on or around them; (b) the unpredictability of the animal's reaction to outside stimulation such as sounds, sudden movement, and unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals; (c) collisions with other animals or objects; or (d) the potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the animal or not acting within his or her ability. Furthermore, I acknowledge that I am a Participant in an equine or livestock activity as defined by Utah Code Ann. 78B-4-201 and that my status as a participant will continue through the duration of the entire event (i.e. even subsequent to my competitive turn).
