

UBRA Winter Series Rules

- Membership Not Required
- Horse & rider must run in draw order
- Pre-entry draw will not be changed.
- Entry fee must be paid to be in the draw.
- Youth 3D (1 sec split), 14 & under as of Nov 1 of start year.
- Open 4D (1/2 sec split)
- All entries taken through SaddleBook, no entry cutoff
- Pre-enter weeknight races until 12:00 noon day of race.
- Pre-enter weekends by 7:00 pm night before.
- Drag every 5.
- Series points based on horse/rider combination
- Payment by CC +3% fee or Venmo @UBRA-racing
- Checks will be available at the following race then mailed. Checks void after 90 days.
- If you need to turn out text Lea Dawn 801-381-3790.

Clarifications

- A \$5 fee per race per rider will be added for insurance and class barrel setter fees.
- Official correspondence will be done by email. It is the contestant's responsibility to make sure the secretary has current contact information and that SaddleBook profile contains current email, phone number and mailing address.
- If a jackpot is cancelled or moved due to weather or arena conditions, it will be cancelled 12 hours prior to start time and members will be notified by phone, email or text message. If weather conditions are adverse or arena conditions are unsafe a function can be cancelled the day of the function with a majority board vote.
- Runners may pre-enter online through SaddleBook per the UBRA website. If a member pre-enters and does not show up to the jackpot without notification, member is responsible to pay entry fee.
- The ground will be raked after every 5 runners.
- Entry fee must be paid to be included in the pre-entry draw. Entry fee must be paid before running.
- There will be no refund of entry fee once a jackpot starts.
- Good sportsmanship and safe conduct is expected at all times.
- Grievances
- For a grievance to be addressed by the board of directors it must be presented to a board member as a grievance, in writing or email within 7 days from the occurrence. The grievance must be signed.
- The grievance will be discussed by the board or directors and dealt with in a timely manner.
- If the grievance regards a UBRA member, all parties may be called before the board of directors.
- The board will make a decision and deal with the parties accordingly.
- The decision made by the board of directors is final.

Violations and Fines

- Any person may be disciplined, fined, suspended or expelled from the association and may be denied any or all privileges of the association whenever it has been established by satisfactory evidence to the board of directors that such person has willfully violated any pertinent rule of the association. All members and competitors are required to read the rule book carefully and are encouraged to ask a board member for clarification if necessary.
- The following items are considered violations, may be subject to fines and will be dealt with by the board of directors accordingly:
- Any competitor found guilty of using alcohol or drugs during a UBRA event or being under the influence of alcohol or drugs while in the arena.
- Horse abuse will not be tolerated.
- Running a horse excessively will not be tolerated.
- Any person who willfully causes trouble inside or outside the ranks of the UBRA by constant complaining, causing disturbances or unnecessary aggravation towards UBRA members, competitors or the board of directors.
- Cheating or willfully misusing a rule.
- Running out of turn or before name is called can result in disqualification.
- All riders are required to clear the arena and begin their run from outside the arena.
- Working a horse on stakes or markers, barrels or poles before the race starts (except time only): \$25 fine
- Circling barrel or pole more than once during a competitive run: \$25 fine

Youth 3D

- The Youth 3D is a full second split and is for the contestant who is 14 years and under as of January 1st of the current year.
- Youth 3D time can be carried over to the 4D.
- Winter Series Points are accumulated on a horse and rider combination.
- Horse and rider combinations are eligible for as many year-end awards as they earn.

Open 4D

- The 4D is a ½ second split, example: 1D 17.000, 2D 17.500, 3D 18.000, 4D 18.500.
- Times can be carried over from the Youth or you can run in the 4D. You must declare your carryover or run option when entering.
- A horse and rider combination may run or carry time over into the 4D one time per jackpot.
- Winter Series points are accumulated on a horse and member rider combination.
- Horse and rider combinations are eligible for as many year-end awards as they earn.
