



**UBRA \$5,000 Added
Rocky Mountain Power 2D Futurity Rules
April 17, 18 and 19, 2026
Wasatch County Events Center, Heber City UT**



Futurity 2D (Full sec split), \$8000 Added & Average Awards

\$300 entry fee, due April 1, 2025 through SaddleBook

Sat & Sun 2D Amateur Side Pot (1/2 sec split) \$40 entry fee, 100% Payback

Photocopy of front & back of registration papers or vet's affidavit must be uploaded with entry in SaddleBook

1. The Futurity is a 2D, full second split.
2. The futurity will start after the KK Barrels Qualifier Saturday and at 9:00 am Sunday. 1st go: Pre-entries followed by late entries. 2nd go: Entire draw is reversed – late entries will run first in reverse order.
3. All runners will enter the arena through the alley way and exit out the alley way. No exceptions. Any runner entering from anywhere other than the alley way will be disqualified. One circle is allowed. If you are in the warm-up arena, please be cautious and courteous of horses running in and out of the alley way. The next 15 runners will be the only horses allowed in the warm-up arena.
4. Futurity entry fee of \$300 due April 10, 2026. See SaddleBook for payment options. Late fee after April 10th is \$50. **Absolutely no refunds of futurity entry fees or late fees – no exceptions.**
5. The Futurity is open to all riders. A rider may ride more than one horse. Owners do not have to ride horses.
6. Dress Code: long sleeve shirt, long pants, boots and western hat or helmet is required in Futurity and all other races Saturday and Sunday.
7. Futurity is open to foals of 2021 & 2022 (4 & 5 years old); copy of both sides of registration papers must be uploaded with entry in SaddleBook. Unregistered horses must show proof of age with a vet's affidavit and must accompany entry in SaddleBook.
8. To be eligible for the Futurity horse must never have competed in a barrel race prior to November 15, 2025.
9. To be eligible for the Amateur 2D side-pot rider cannot have won more than \$2,000 lifetime in barrel racing futurities prior to November 15, 2025, and never before held a WPRA Card.
10. Horse or Rider futurity substitution will be allowed for death, illness or unsoundness with a \$25 change fee and Vet / Dr. release. Cannot substitute both horse and rider. Notify Kristi Brangle 801-440-0827. Email release to krbrangle@hotmail.com **Deadline for substitution is Tuesday, April 14, 2026.** \$25 change fee must be paid at time of substitution.
11. Futurity buy-outs will be allowed with payment of a \$25 fee and will be handled by The UBRA. **Buy-out deadline is Tuesday, April 14th.** **Absolutely no refunds of futurity nomination or entry fees – no exceptions.**

12. 70% of entry fee & 100% of added money will be jackpotted. All nomination fees and payments will be included in payout. Two go's and an average will be paid in the Futurity: 60% to 1D, 40% to 2D. (1st go 30%, 2nd go 30%, Average 40%).
13. Average prizes and money will be awarded in the futurity. A true average system using the combined horse & rider's times from each day will determine the futurity average champion and 2D futurity average champion. Must be present or have a designated person pick up your award.
14. Futurity riders must check in on Friday, April 17th to pick up a saddle pad number for each futurity horse entered. A copy of registration papers is required at check in. Horses are not needed to check in.
15. Late nominations may be made by paying a \$50 late fee. The last day to enter the Futurity is Friday April 18, 2026 by 2 p.m. All fees must be paid through SaddleBook. Late fees and substitution fees will be retained by the UBRA.
16. Horses running in Futurity **may carry over** time to Youth, High Stakes, Open 5D and any eligible side-pots.
17. Stall & RV Reservations are handled by Wasatch County and done online. To reserve stalls see www.utbra.com Heber Races page and follow the link to Wasatch County's stall reservation system. No tying at trailers over-night and no outside shavings are allowed.
18. Dogs are not allowed inside the barn but can be tied to trailers.
19. Ground will be raked every 5 runners with a tractor and big drags will be determined. Horses will not be worked on markers, barrels are not allowed in the arena during open ride or any other time April 17-19, 2026 except during time only.
